Whole-Lake Treatment to Control Fanwort



Prior treatments in 2005 and 2011 have kept this invader from killing the Pond.





2014 Survey Findings

- 2014 weed survey was our 7th comprehensive assessment
- Fanwort covered 11% of the Pond last year vs.
 50% in 2004 (before our first treatment) and 6% (before our 2011 treatment)
- Total plant cover in 2014 down by a third from 2004 (54% vs. 79%)
- Most of the Main Pond remains fanwort-free
- Pond has richer variety of native submersed and floating plants today than in 2004

2014: Fanwort Distribution








Approved Program

- Treatment plan prepared by our lake management consultant and approved by Andover Conservation Commission
- Complies with Order of Conditions, State GEIR, and State licensing requirements
- Whole-lake Sonar treatment (liquid and slowrelease pellets) at drinking water-safe concentration (<20 ppb)
- Treatment cost: \$41,765 (less than 2005 and 2011)









Treatment Plan Considerations

- Foster's Pond has responded well to Sonar treatment
 - ► Most ponds need whole-lake treatments every 2-3 years to control fanwort; we've treated whole Pond in 2005 and 2011, 18 acres in 2007
 - We've had no adverse effects to fish or wildlife, and native plant diversity has increased
- Sonar remains the only practical control
- Sonar is approved for use in public water supplies

Water Use Restrictions


- No swimming, boating, fishing on day of any Sonar treatment
- No use of Pond water for irrigation for 30 days following last Sonar treatment (90-120 days total depending on number of "booster" treatments)



Algae







Before and after 2013 algae treatment. >70,000 cell/ml is considered unhealthful. Highest count last year was 31,000 cells/ml.



Hydro-raking

- Unlikely this year because of weed treatment
- Depends on sufficient # of participants
- Performed in the Fall to minimize algae
- Each shoreline owner pays
- Advance signup required
